The Highlights

In addition to the services provided to Wyandot County children and adults with developmental disabilities, 2023 included the following organizational accomplishments:

- Wyandot County DD was awarded a 3-year accreditation by the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities. The 3-year award is the highest level of achievement.
- Angeline Preschool achieved a 5-Star Step Up To Quality award by the Ohio Department of Education. The 5-Star is the highest award possible.



On July 1, 2023 Wyandot County DD successfully completed the privatization of Angeline Industries. The federal government's Center for Medicaid Services (CMS) required that Angeline Industries separate from Wyandot County DD and operate as its own private provider agency. Wyandot County DD remains responsible for funding the services Angeline Industries provides to local citizens with developmental disabilities, the same way Wyandot County DD pays all other private service providers (e.g., group home operators, employment programs, etc.).
