

## The Highlights

In addition to the services provided to Wyandot County children and adults with developmental disabilities, 2024 included the following organizational accomplishments:

- Angeline Preschool achieved the Gold Standard Step Up To Quality award by the Ohio Department of Education, which is the highest level of award attainable.
- Wyandot County DD wrote for and obtained a \$60,000 grant from the Ohio Department of DD to promote community accessibility and inclusion projects within Wyandot County. We then awarded four separate \$15,000 inclusion grants to the Village of Carey, Mohawk Schools, and Upper Sandusky Parks Department for their accessible playground projects. As well as to the Wyandot County Fair Board for the purchase and furnishing of The Sensory Barn: a quiet space on the fairgrounds for children and adults with autism and other sensory sensitivities.





• Wyandot County DD partnered with WestCON COG for a grant to purchase two fully accessible mobile restroom trailers with a universal changing table. We then placed one of the trailers on the fairgrounds for Fair Week.
